

A. DRESS CODE

Employees must remember that they represent the image of the City to the public. Therefore, City employees are expected to dress in appropriate business attire, and employees are expected to dress in a reasonably clean and neat manner which will enable them to perform their job duties. The employee's supervisor or department head retains discretion to ask the employee to return home and change if his/her attire is inappropriate or inconsistent with the City image or public service. Employees who are sent home to change clothes will not be paid for their time away from work.

Certain employees are required to wear uniforms. Employees who fail to wear uniforms may be disciplined. Other employees may be required to wear certain color combinations, but the City shall not provide such clothing.
