THE CITY OF COMMERCE REQUEST FOR WITHDRAWAL OF SIGNATURE FROM PETITION

Background

A voter who has signed an initiative or referendum petition, and who subsequently wishes his or her name withdrawn, may do so by filing a written request for the withdrawal with the appropriate elections official that includes the voter's name, residence address, and signature. This request must be filed in the elections official's office prior to the date the petition is filed. (*California Elections Code section 9602*)

Deadline

The request for withdrawal must be **received** in the City Clerk's Office, including those that are mailed, emailed or faxed, prior to the date that the petition is officially filed with the City Clerk. *A mailed request for withdrawal that is postmarked prior to the date the petition is filed, but received after the date the petition is filed, will not be accepted.*
