

## Camp Commerce Packing List

We hope that you will enjoy your visit to Camp Commerce. Each cabin is furnished with a restroom (toilet paper is supplied), twin size bunk beds and a heater. Meals will be prepared and served in the lodge. All other items are to be provided by the visitor. The following is a recommended packing list:

### Cabin Essentials:

Bedding – blanket and sheets or sleeping bag

Pillow and pillow case

Toiletries – shampoo, soap/body wash, toothbrush, toothpaste, mouthwash, floss, deodorant, shaving items, feminine products, brush/comb, hand soap and/or hand sanitizer.

Medication, sunblock, anti-itch ointment and/or insect repellent.

Towels – bath, hand and beach.

Disinfecting wipes.

### Personal Essentials (consider weather conditions):

Clothing - t-shirts/tank tops, shorts, pants/jeans, jacket/raincoat, sweater, sweatshirt/sweatpants, pajamas, robe, undergarments

Headgear – beanie, scarf, bandanna, baseball cap/sunhat, eyeglasses, sunglasses

Shoes – boots, tennis shoes, sandals/flip-flops, socks

Pool/lake attire - bathing suit/swim trunks, beach towel, cover-up, goggles

Snow attire - weatherproof jacket, snow pants/bib, waterproof shoes and/or snow boots, gloves

Chapstick, sunblock

Electronics, chargers

Reusable water bottle or canteen

Flashlight, Umbrella

Bags/duffels/totes

Car seat or Booster seat- Per California State Law, children must be seated in the rear seat of a vehicle in an appropriate car seat or booster seat until they are 8 years old or 4'9" tall. Children must remain in a rear facing car seat until they weigh 40 pounds or more or are at least 40 inches tall. Therefore, if your child is within this range, please be sure to bring your child's car seat/booster when traveling to camp.
